1. Public participation

Marjorie Gartenberg of Stagecoach and an advocate of Silver Taskers read her comments regarding numerous requests for Lyon County to hire a Code Enforcement Officer. A copy has been made a part of the record.

3. Presentation of awards and/or recognition of accomplishments

There were no other awards or recognitions.

4. Commissioners/County Manager comments

Comm. Fierro commented on the Carson Water Subconservancy District meeting. They discussed flood control in the Stephanie Way area in Douglas County due to microbursts that ended up with localized flooding.

Jeff Page commented on the small number of people awarded for years of service. This was partially due to the elimination of 30% of the workforce in 2011. He said the employees that are doing things right need to be complimented. He said it is a challenge to hire and retain quality people to work in the public sector any more. He also said he received a call for the Federal Aviation Administration and they will not be awarding the second planning grant for the Silver

Springs Airport LLC and most likely will not award it until the Silver Springs Airport Master Plan is done. He should be receiving official notice from the FAA any day. He has also been working with the City of Yerington, Nevada Copper and others regarding the industrial area near Nevada Copper's property. He met with the City of Fernley's Manager to discuss future revenues and the sharing of services. He said the Title 15 issues on the agenda today to request an extension. The county manager asked that the public comment period be extended to five minutes during the discussion involving the contract with Farr West Engineering, Item #32.

5. Elected Official's report

Clerk/Treasurer Nikki Bryan complimented Lyon County staff for all of their help during early voting and the primary election. She said the county has an awesome team and she truly appreciated all of their help.

Sheriff McNeil said four people retired this month from the sheriff's department with approx. 100 years of cumulative service. The lantern fest held last weekend in Fernley had about 7,000 spectators. The promoters needed to go through proper permitting before the event. There was also a two day event held at the schools for emergency response plans. The program focused on how to isolate the schools, where to tell the parents to go so they are not clogging up roads and how to get resources to the scene as quickly as possible.

Comm. Hastings asked if VIP's could help with traffic control during the lantern fest in Fernley. He also commented on the programs at the schools and making the kids safe.

27. For Possible Action – Approve proper allocation of budget dollars of \$86,446 put into the Sheriff’s budget as a clerical error in the 2016-2017 Final Budget

Comptroller Josh Foli apologized for the error but said one additional deputy position was included in the sheriff’s budget.

Administrative Director Michael Carlson requested \$40,000 for three part time administrative positions. One would serve in the Dayton substation, one in the Fernley substation and the third person would serve as an evidence technician. These positions are non-benefit/non-PERS and would be limited to not more than 19 hours per week. The cost is estimated at \$12,624 per part time position. Last November the sheriff’s department had to downsize staff in the Dayton and Fernley substations.

Sheriff Al McNeil explained the need for an evidence manager.

Comm. Hunewill asked about the contract to get rid of stuff in evidence.

Comptroller Josh Foli said he would support the request of the sheriff’s department but feels that \$55,000 of the funds should be allocated to Human Service for a full time position since the person who was part time retired. The difference could go to the sheriff’s department to fund the three part time positions with an additional \$6,000 to be approved from the turnover savings in the budget.

Comptroller Jeff Page supports Josh Foli's recommendation. He said the Human Resources Director is working between 60 and 80 hours per week. Christie Reeder is the only person in that department and feels the additional person in Human Resources is needed.

Sheriff McNeil was in agreement with Josh Foli's recommendation.

Comm. Fierro moved to approve the transfer of \$86,446 that was a clerical error, to be placed in the budget as Comptroller Josh Foli mentioned in his presentation. Comm. Hunewill seconded and the motion passed 4 – 0. Absent: Comm. Mortensen

10:00 A.M. – Public Hearing on Nuisance Complaint – For Possible Action: The Lyon County Board of Commissioners will consider the Public Nuisance Complaint existing at 4 Ny-Jo Road, Yerington, NV

Maureen Williss presented the original photographs taken of the property. She also presented recent photos that show there have been some improvements. She said a representative of Ms. Scodak came in and asked for an extension of time to finish cleaning up the property. Maureen Williss informed him he would need to appear before the board of commissioners because she did not have the authority to grant an extension.

Gary Hickey said they are cleaning up property and will not be adding any additional debris. He is in the process of recycling travel trailers. He said when he is done with cleaning up the property there will be no more than two unregistered vehicles at that location. He would like some additional time to complete the project. He said that a 60 day extension will be sufficient.

Maureen Williss said she has been in contact with the property owners for two years and felt that a 60 day extension would be reasonable.

Comm. Alt moved to declare the property at 4 Ny-Jo Road a public nuisance and approve a 60 day extension to clean up the property; if 60 days is not sufficient, he can come before the board to request additional time. Comm. Hunewill seconded and the motion passed 4 – 0. Absent: Comm. Mortensen

Marjorie Gartenberg offered Mr. Hickey help from the Silver Taskers. She said they have 23 free or viable programs to help in the cleanup efforts and she will provide Mr. Hickey with the list of the programs that are available to possibly assist him with cleaning up the property.

28. For Possible Action - Approve the annual resolution of the Lyon County Board of Commissioners to designate the number of cents on each one hundred dollars of property tax levied for each fund and authorize the levy of the tax required for FY 2016-2017 (requested by Comptroller)

County Manager Jeff Page said this is the annual resolution required by statute.

Comptroller Josh Foli said there were no tax increases by Lyon County. Mason Valley Fire, Smith Valley Fire and North Lyon County Fire Protection Districts all changed their tax rates during the year as allowed by board action under NRS. The remaining districts and entities kept their tax rates the same.

Comptroller Jeff Page said the county is at the cap and cannot raise the tax rate.

Comm. Fierro moved to approve the annual resolution of the Lyon County Board of Commissioners to designate the number of cents on each one hundred dollars of property tax levied for each fund and authorize the levy of the tax required for FY 2016-2017. Comm. Hunewill seconded and the motion passed 4 – 0. Absent: Comm. Mortensen

29. For Possible Action - Approve the fee resolution for all Lyon County Departments for 2016/2017 (requested by Comptroller)

County Manager Jeff Page said there are no significant changes to the fee resolution. He was directed by the board to take a look at the Community Development fees because of the

discussion regarding a possible contract with Farr West Engineering. Depending on the decision on the contract, he would like to include Farr West Engineering in the discussion regarding those fees. Mr. Page said the Community Development fees have not been raised in a number of years.

Comm. Hastings commented on fees possibly being refunded if a decision is overturned in an appeal.

Comm. Fierro moved to approve the fee resolution for all Lyon County Departments for 2016/2017. Comm. Hunewill seconded and the motion passed 4 – 0. Absent: Comm. Mortensen

30. For Possible Action - Adopt a resolution authorizing the transfer of funds for FY2015-2016 from various line items, including Contingency, within the General Fund as authorized by NRS 354.598005

Comptroller Josh Foli said this is a formality for transfers that were previously approved by the board.

Comm. Fierro moved to adopt a resolution authorizing the transfer of funds for FY2015-2016 from various line items, including Contingency, within the General Fund as authorized by NRS 354.598005. Comm. Alt seconded and the motion passed 4 – 0. Absent: Comm. Mortensen.

31. For Possible Action - Request for authorization for part time staffing to enter warrants.

County Manager Jeff Page said this is a request from Judge Vecchiarelli and is in support of her request. He said it is within their budget for the part time position.

Comm. Fierro moved to approve the request for authorization for part time staffing to enter warrants. Comm. Alt seconded and the motion passed 4 – 0. Absent: Comm. Mortensen

32. For Possible Action – Approve contract with Farr West Engineering to provide Community Development and Building Department contract services to begin as soon as feasible on or after July 1, 2016 and eliminate four County positions being contracted.

Comptroller Jeff Page explained the first zoning and land use codes were adopted in 1974 and staff was put in place to implement the codes that have now become the Community Development Department. He explained that it has become more challenging to hire qualified people for the open positions. Some of the smaller cities and counties have begun contracting those services. He said the Community Development Director retired in May and they looked into contracting with a firm to take over the Community Development needs. He presented a contract from Farr West Engineering that if approved, would take effect on July 1, 2016. The two building inspectors in that department would become employees of Farr West Engineering. Mr. Page said if the situation with Farr West Engineering were to unravel, the two building inspectors would be offered their jobs back with Lyon County if they are still employees of Farr West Engineering. They will be holding a couple of meetings with the development community to develop some processes to get their projects moving forward. He said the planning staff will stay intact.

Comptroller Josh Foli explained they are anticipating a salary and benefit savings of about \$30,000. If the contract amount was higher due to Title 15, there would be budget dollars available to the board to increase the contract as needed for those services.

There were questions regarding specialized engineering services.

County Manager Jeff Page said the two employees that will become Farr West Engineering employees will work from their current locations, one in Yerington and the other in Dayton.

President of Farr West Engineering Brent Farr explained the company was founded 15 years ago; the City of Yerington was their first client and Lyon County was their second. He said that the

City of Yerington and Lyon County have been very loyal clients and he appreciates their business.

Dustin Urton of Smith Valley had questions regarding the possibility of permit fees increasing. He can't see how the county could save \$30,000 accepting the Farr West Engineering contract. He expressed concerns about the two Lyon County employees becoming Farr West Engineering employees.

Jeff Page said the county can't get qualified people to apply for the job openings with the proper certifications. He said Lyon County will be taking a close look at the building fees.

Lanona Higley of Stagecoach had questions about code enforcement officers in other counties.

Gene Stewart of the Lyon County building department asked about the benefit package that Farr West is going to offer. He agrees that the county does need expertise in certain areas. He said the county does not have the staff to handle the additional work that may be coming in.

Reverend Richard Blane of Silver Springs asked about the possibility of raising fees.

Jeff Page explained how fees could be raised and approved by the commissioners.

Angela DeFord complimented the employees in the community development department.

Utilities Director Mike Workman explained the need for some engineering experiences because the county does not have the expertise. He sees this contract as an opportunity to bring continuity to the county. He said the county does not have the engineering staff to handle many of the issues. He mentioned some of the challenges the county is facing. He discussed water rights issues and utilities.

Lyon County Building Inspector Joel Brown wanted to know the terms of Farr West Engineering's contract.

Comptroller Josh Foli explained that Lyon County approached Farr West Engineering about coming together with a contract.

Scott Keller felt that going with Farr West will be a benefit to the Silver Springs area.

Joel Brown said he is only concerned with his and Gene Stewart's positions.

Carol Godwin of Silver Springs said one of the duties of the commissioners is providing leadership by mediating conflicting interests while building consensus. She feels there are concerns regarding the contract.

County Manager Jeff Page addressed some of Joel Brown's concerns and said the contract has been published on the state and Lyon County website since Thursday of last week. There is also a hardcopy on the table in the lobby.

Brent Farr of Farr West Engineering said the company is a stable growing company that employs 70 people. He feels his company provides flexibility and growth potential. He briefly explained their benefit program.

Comm. Hunewill and Comm. Fierro had concerns regarding the wellbeing of the two county employees who would become Farr West employees.

Gene Stewart felt the contract was good for the county.

Christy Reeder said she has met with Joel Brown and Gene Stewart. She said the package is very similar to what the county offers and there could be advantages with Farr West Engineering. She did acknowledge that PERS may be a concern. She said the Farr West has a good retirement plan.

Comm. Alt moved to approve the contract with Farr West Engineering to provide Community Development and Building Department contract services to begin as soon as feasible on or after July 1, 2016 and eliminate four County positions being contracted. Comm. Hastings seconded and the motion passed 3 – 1. Opposed: Comm. Hunewill; absent: Comm. Mortensen.

10:45 A.M. – Public Hearing on Nuisance Complaint – For Possible Action: The Lyon County Board of Commissioners will consider the Public Nuisance Complaint existing at 125 El Dorado Avenue, Dayton, NV 89403

Maureen Williss said this property has been cleaned up and recommended dismissing the complaint. She said the property owner was sent all of the proper notifications. Maureen Williss provided before and after pictures of the property.

Jan Walden said he was born in another country and wished to comply with county code. He said he is very proud to be a citizen of Nevada.

Comm. Fierro moved to dismiss the Public Nuisance Complaint existing at 125 El Dorado Avenue, Dayton, Nevada 89403 because the property has been cleaned up to the satisfaction of the county. Comm. Hunewill seconded and the motion passed 4 – 0. Absent: Comm. Mortensen.

10:45 A.M. – Public Hearing on Nuisance Complaint – For Possible Action: The Lyon County Board of Commissioners will consider the Public Nuisance Complaint existing at 3340 W. Fir Street, Silver Springs, NV 89429

Maureen Williss said this complaint is a fairly new complaint and she has not had any contact with the property owner. She sent a letter on March 15, 2016 and the certified letter was returned unclaimed. She had the sheriff's department go to the property to serve the owner but he refused to accept the letter. All certified letters have been returned unclaimed. She presented pictures of the property showing a considerable amount of debris on the property.

District Attorney Steve Rye said the commissioners could declare it a public nuisance. An order would then be prepared declaring it a public nuisance and if the property owner fails to clean up the property, the county would have the option of cleaning it up and putting the cost of cleanup back on the property.

Comm. Alt asked for an explanation as to what makes this property a nuisance.

County Manager Jeff Page read County Code 6.01.02 regarding a public nuisance into the record.

Comm. Fierro moved to declare the property at 3340 West Fir Street, Silver Springs, NV, a public nuisance under the County Code. Comm. Hunewill seconded and the motion passed 3 – 1. Opposed: Comm. Alt; absent: Comm. Mortensen.

Lanona Higley of Stagecoach said the property should be declared a nuisance.

Maureen Williss said there were originally five nuisance complaints to be heard today. One was removed prior to the agenda going out because it had been cleaned up and the other property was taken care of prior to today's meeting. She is happy to work with the property owners if they communicate with her.

33. For Possible Action – Approve the Facilities Department reorganization by eliminating a vacant Building and Grounds Worker II position, reclassifying the Lead Custodian position to a Custodian Supervisor position and increasing the hours of a temporary custodial position to a part-time position at 30 hours per pay period.

County Manager Jeff Page explained that Tim Ogle said the reorganization will actually have some savings.

Comptroller Josh Foli explained that the board also needs to authorize the comptroller to move the dollars between budgets.

Comm. Fierro moved to approve the Facilities Department reorganization by eliminating a vacant Building and Grounds Worker II position, reclassifying the Lead Custodian position to a Custodian Supervisor position and increasing the hours of a temporary custodial position to a part-time position at 30 hours per pay period and authorize the comptroller to move the funds to the appropriate department. Comm. Hunewill seconded and the motion passed 4 – 0. Absent: Comm. Mortensen

10:15 A.M. – Public Hearing on Nuisance Complaint – For Possible Action: The Lyon County Board of Commissioners will consider the Public Nuisance Complaint existing at 11 Cardon Lane, Yerington, NV 89447

Maureen Williss presented the copies of the complaints and photos that were taken. This issue has been going on since 2014 and she has had no contact from the property owner until today.

Property owner Charles Shaw appeared before the board and said he has not been in the area. He said he will get the property cleaned up and will comply with county code.

Comm. Hunewill said the property appears to be a fire hazard.

Comm. Fierro moved to declare the property at 11 Cardon Lane, Yerington, Nevada a public nuisance and will allow the property owner a 60 day period to clean up the property and also authorize staff to approve an additional 30 days if needed. Comm. Hunewill seconded and the motion passed 4 – 0. Absent: Comm. Mortensen

Marjorie Gartenberg of the Silver Taskers offered assistance. She will present Mr. Shaw with a list of the free and viable programs available to possibly assist with the cleaning up of the property.

Jim Dunlap commented on licensing and insuring of vehicles sitting on the property.

34. For Possible Action - Discussion and direction to the Dayton Valley Event Center Board on the future of the board and operation, maintenance and improvements to the Dayton Valley Event Center (requested by Dayton Valley Event Center Board)

Bill Murray of the Dayton Valley Event Center Board said they have been struggling to keep the 80 acre facility maintained partially due to the decrease in county funding. He said the stands are deteriorating and they need funding and some direction on future use of the facility. He discussed possible grant funding for operation and maintenance.

Comm. Fierro said it is an ideal location for rodeos, off road vehicle events or concerts.

Stoney Tennant member of Dayton Valley Event Center Board gave brief history of the facility. He said interest in rodeos has decreased. He said building permits were required for any construction needed and it needs to be done by a licensed contractor. There have been complaints about noise. They need funds to make improvements to the facility. There are also issues regarding fire and water concerns. He feels a \$50,000 investment is needed. He asked about a possible recreational grant.

Comm. Fierro asked if the event center would qualify for park tax funding.

Mike Workman said it does not qualify for park tax. He gave the board credit for their hard work. He said it would cost about \$400,000 just to get a water pipe to the facility and would be dependent on other users. He commented on the engineering costs.

Stoney Tennant said the existing well doesn't produce much. He put in two 10,000 gallon water tanks to provide water to the grounds.

Comm. Fierro commented on the money already spent on the facility.

Bill Murray said they can't afford the engineering to determine the cost of the needed improvements.

Stoney Tennant asked about turning the maintenance over to parks and recreation.

County Manager Jeff Page recommended tabling this Item for 30 days to allow him and staff time to meet with Stoney Tennant and his group to see if the county can come up with a plan. During the past year members of our communities have presented numerous requests to the Board for the hiring of a Compliance /Code enforcement Officer only to be told that there is not sufficient funds in the budget.

It not only behooves the Board to hire such but also would endorse the compliance of County Codes already in copy. Now that the policy is the outsource certain positions , the Community Development Division and its underpinned departments , the leader of that department needs to be the one handling complaints and not a secretary.

Presently, the county Manager's secretary handles complaints of code violations and decides whether they have any basis, will be honored, processes complaints that are deemed " relevant, sends letters out , and keeps a file or actually discards them. These actions are done without a stated policy statement.

In early 2016 , during a Board of Commissioners Meeting a request was made to Mr. Page that an office policy be established to have updates available to those that used their time ,effort, and supplied a complaint (often accompanied by pictures) to be available to the persons who wrote the complaint. This request was made to help us understand the timing of Due Process. Mr. Page agreed that the request could be done within his scope as Manager and as an office policy.

To our dismay , we have noticed that some complaints were actually destroyed, thrown away, and not "deemed noticeable " to be addressed. Upon inquiry we are told that nothing can be done.

This is untenable!

If in fact, the Community Development Department and its underpinned departments are responsible for building codes, zoning codes, health and safety codes, —all complaints need to be directed and serviced under this supervision, not a secretary's.

I urge the Board to consider such a change that would allow this cause for clean-up, community beatification, and creating a better county image .
