The 38th Annual Dayton Valley Days is a two-day, family-friendly community festival that celebrates our historic past while showcasing local arts & crafts vendors, museum tours, a Kiwanis pancake breakfast, mule cart rides, a pet parade, a kids zone, and plenty of food trucks. This year, we added a professional stage featuring local performers such as Jacked-Up Lake Tahoe, Morgan Mackenzie, Greg Austin and Carson Chandler, along with a car show that had 108 entries. Many local businesses and nonprofits also took part, highlighting the strong community spirit of the event.

Last year marked the fifth year the Dayton Chamber of Commerce organized the festival, drawing as many as 15,000 attendees. Vendors came from all over Nevada and one vendor was from Idaho. Even though Dayton does not have lodging options, the event continues to bring visitors and vendors who stay in surrounding communities—showcasing its regional appeal. We do have the Dayton RV Park and the State Park that are used by vendors and event attendees. The Chamber is committed to expanding advertising efforts to attract even more guests from farther away, ensuring Dayton Valley Days remains a signature event that boosts local visibility, tourism, and economic activity.
