

Stagecoach Advisory Board Minutes

1. **Call to Order:** Meeting called to order by Charles Shirley at 7:00 p.m.
2. **Roll Call:** Quorum is present. In attendance: Charles Shirley, Amanda Brinnand, David Palmer, Timothy Frank, & Casandra Aveiro
3. **Pledge of Allegiance**
4. **Public Participation:** None
5. **For Possible Action: Review and adoption of agenda.** Amanda made a motion to approve the agenda. The motion was seconded by Cassandra and passed 5/0.
6. **For Possible Action:** Appoint board Chair for 2026 and the first meeting of 2028. Timothy made a motion to appoint Charles Shirley. The motion was seconded by Amanda and passed 5/0
7. **For Possible Action:** Appoint board Vice Chair for 2026 and the first meeting of 2028. Cassandra made a motion to appoint Amanda. The motion was seconded by Timothy and passed 5/0
8. **For Possible Action:** Appoint board Secretary for 2026 and the first meeting of 2028. Amanda made a motion to appoint David. The motion was seconded by Timothy and passed 5/0.
9. **For Possible Action:** Approval of Stagecoach Advisory Board December 3, 2025, minutes. Timothy made a motion to approve the minutes, and it was seconded by Cassandra. Motion Passed 5/0.

10. Chair and Board Member Comments

Casandra – Stated that she was glad everyone is here and that she was sad that she missed the WWII Memorial rededication ceremony.

Timothy – Stated that he was glad that everyone showed up and that it is nice to see the new Fire Chief in attendance.

David – Wished everyone a happy New Year,

Amanda – Thanked everyone that attended the WWII Memorial rededication ceremony and said that it was an awesome event.

Charles – Thanked everyone for coming out this evening and thanked everyone that helped with the rededication ceremony and noted that people from multiple communities participated in the ceremony.

11. Community Reports

- A. **Lyon County Commissioner/Manager Office** – Commissioner Tammy Hendrix provided an update regarding various activities of the Lyon County Commissioners. Activities included elected officers and making committee assignments. Winston Solar application for a Planned Unit Development (PUD) requested certain variances was tabled. In response to a question related to the status of the gas station at US 50 and USA Parkway, Tammy stated that the information that she has is that they are still working through issues with the ingress and egress with NDOT. She also noted a similar project was approved at the corner of US 50 and 6 mile canyon.
- B. **Public Safety: Sheriff Department/NHP** – Rebecca Martinez spoke on behalf of the Sheriff's office and indicated that Commander Miller had to respond to an incident and was therefore unable to make it to the meeting.

- C. **Central Lyon County Parks and Recreation** – Not present
- D. **Silver Springs Area Chamber of Commerce** – Amanda shared that the Hometown Christmas event was great. Activities included a Parade of Lights, distribution of presents, tree lighting, and craft fair. Leftover presents were taken to Silver Stage Elementary school for distribution.
- E. **Central Lyon Fire District** – New fire Chief Tim McHargue attended and noted that he has been on the job for 97 days. Prior to taking the CLFD job, he spent 35 years in the fire service and was a fire chief in the city of Colton, California until he retired in June 2024. After accepting the job, he bought a house in Virginia City. He is a huge advocate of transparency and is here to serve the community. In response to a question about burn permits, he stated that they are working on new software and there are some hiccups, but they are working on that.

12. Correspondence – None.

13. Future Agenda Items – Hoping to have a public safety day in the spring to include the Fire Dept, LCSO and VIP (Volunteering in Policing), Wild Horse Connection, Lyon County Health & Human Services, and potentially other organizations. Amanda also noted that there seems to be a lot of misinformation about data centers and water so she suggested putting together a workshop with experts to provide accurate information.

14. Public Participation – Timothy noted that the Veterans Healing Camp is under new management and they are closing the doors on his Veterans Outreach program. However, he does have an outreach scheduled on 1/15 at the Silver Springs Community Center.
