For January, 2026

January was budget time, as we just reviewed.

Also it was time to touch bases with our partners and associates. I have had meetings with Dylan Morris, (Morris Ag-Air), Jerry Frey, (Frey Spray). Both planes will be available for our larger aerial needs. Andy at Ascent Solutions, will also be available, with his drones, for any smaller aerial work. This season we are back to having plenty of aerial support.

There is always some kind of issue though, last week, Troy Hilderbrant, our seasonal employee, informed me that he isn't able to return this season! I may have to hire a new employee and start training all over again. I will let you know next meeting, I have a couple of possible solutions to check into first.

I am not going to be able to attend the upcoming AMCA meeting in March. I have a personal issue to attend to, that conflicts with those dates.

Chemical orders are next! I will be placing orders this month for most of our larvicides. We are down on all liquid formulations of Altosid and BTI. Also I will be getting more Altosid XRGU Sand, as well as 8-10 cases of long term briquets. As long as we don't get hit by any unusual events, (floods, ect.), this will be our big order of the season.

One more thing, I am going to order better tires for the Can-Am, The stock tires will not hold up to the stickers we have here, so I am looking into the best style/brand.
