

Stagecoach Advisory Board Minutes

Wednesday, February 4, 2026, 7:00 PM

Stagecoach Community Center, 8204 Highway 50 Stagecoach, Nevada

1. **Call to Order:** Meeting called to order by Charles Shirley at 7:00 p.m.
2. **Roll Call:** Quorum is present. In attendance: Charles Shirley, Amanda Brinnand, David Palmer, Timothy Frank, & Casandra Aveiro
3. **Pledge of Allegiance**
4. **Public Participation:** None
5. **For Possible Action: Review and adoption of agenda.** Timothy made a motion to approve the agenda. The motion was seconded by David and passed 5/0.
6. **For Possible Action:** Approval of Stagecoach Advisory Board January 7, 2026, minutes. Timothy made a motion to approve the minutes, and it was seconded by Cassandra. Motion Passed 5/0.

7. Chair and Board Member Comments

Casandra – Stated that she was glad to see everyone.

Timothy – Happy to see some new faces and encourages everyone to come back on a regular basis.

David – No comment

Amanda – No comment.

Charles – Thanked everyone for coming out this evening.

8. **For Discussion Only: Stagecoach Safety Day** – As a follow up to prior discussions, Amanda asked for input on potential organizations to participate in the Safety Day. Potential groups that were suggested include: Central Lyon Fire, Lyon County Sheriff and Search & Rescue, NHP, Wild Horse Connection, LRTC (Large Animal Rescue) 775 Offroad Rescue, Red Cross. In regard to timing, suggestions include a Saturday in, June, August or September. Nick Hernandez (Central Lyon Fire) suggested possibly using the Fire Station with an Open House and pancake breakfast.

9. Community Reports

- A. **Lyon County Commissioner/Manager Office** – Commissioner Tammy Hendrix provided an update regarding various activities of the Lyon County Commissioners. Tammy reported that Commission Keller and herself are attending the National Association of Counties (NACO) conference in D.C. during which time they will meet with congressional delegates and submit various capital improvement requests.
- B. **Public Safety: Sheriff Department/NHP** – Commander Miller reported that in January they responded to 542 calls for service in Silver Springs (SS) and 33 in Stagecoach (SC); made 11 arrests in SS and none in SC, had traffic stops 152 in SS and 7 in SC; Citations 34 in SS and 3 in SC and reports written 52 related to SS and none for SC. In response to a comment from Charles expressing concern about people going to houses in the evening when no one is home, Commander Miller stated that he will have his team increase patrols at night in Stagecoach.
- C. **Central Lyon County Parks and Recreation** – Not present
- D. **Silver Springs Area Chamber of Commerce** – Richard Mitroz thanked the Sheriff's office and Fire

department for their involvement in the Christmas event and noted that left over toys want to the Silver Stage Elementary school for distribution. Richard also noted their next meeting will be on February 19th at which time they will be doing planning for the year, discuss how to grow the Chamber and to generate more revenue. He also noted that Waste Management, Sky Fiber and NNIC (Northern Nevada Industrial Center) recently joined the Chamber. He also noted that we have two new businesses in Stagecoach: Prospector Pizza and Feeds Direct

E. **Central Lyon Fire District** – Nick Hernandez, Battalion Chief here in Stagecoach Station 37 reported that they had 403 calls to date in 2026 most of which were for EMS services. He also noted that they have a project to develop large scale evacuation plans along with the Sheriff’s office and other entities. They are also looking at potential applications for broadcasting announcements such as evacuations, traffic rerouting, etc. He also noted that the Stagecoach station has 14 members on staff now thanks to taxpayers.

10. Correspondence – Amanda noted that we received notice that the Annual training for the Citizens Advisory Board members is scheduled on April 11 at the Senior Center.

11. Future Agenda Items – Amanda noted that we will roll over the Stagecoach Safety Day topic as we develop plans and potential dates.

12. Public Participation – Richard stated that Michael Blueit is not on the COC Board and is providing valuable insights. Timothy noted that starting April 15th, Amvets will be at the Senior Center every other Friday to help veterans. Timothy also state that they will have a table set up in front of Prospectors Pizza on Feb. 21st and that they have public transportation available for Veterans
