\$5000.00 and the \$2500.00 packets and include the derby tickets with their packets. Board discussed Box Seat tickets versus general admission tickets. Board agreed that if the box seats are available then, it would be a first-come first-serving basis for the box seats, whoever sends the money first. Keep the General admission amounts the same. Increase the \$5000.00 sponsorship to 6 Box seats in the box seat or 20 general admission tickets. \$2500.00 will be 12 General Admission tickets and 4 demo derby tickets not box seat option.

Security—Lisa Tibbals stated that they spoke with High Desert Security at the Western Fair Convention and she gave them all of our information, they did a bid but it was double of what we paid Fun Events last year; She asked if they would negotiate the price and she will call them and see what they would do; Fun Events is also interested and will be sending a bid;

Entertainment—Lisa Tibbals stated that they were able to confirm up entertainment at Western Fairs; After reviewing the cost of all the entertainers, we need to add some money to our Entertainment budget; Lisa Tibbals would like to increase the entertainment budget by about \$6000.00, we haven't increased that line item for entertainment for a long time; Josh Foli stated that we don't have to have a motion we just have to make sure we have a balanced budget. So, board discussed all options for Entertainment.

Acrobats—Bid of \$4000.00 plus motel rooms same as last year; Donna McDonald made motion to approve the bid for Acrobats; Crystal White seconded; Motion Carried; Unanimous
James the Juggler—Bid of \$3600.00, same as last year with one motel room; Eric Glasglow made motion to approve the \$3600 bid plus room; Donna McDonald seconded; Motion Carried; Unanimous.

Kiddle Karo—Bid of \$5000.00 and motel room same as last year; Eric Glasglow made motion to approve the bid for \$5000 plus rooms; Stefanie Moxley seconded; Motion Carried; Unanimous

Powerhouse—Lisa Tibbals stated he has not raised the price for us for several years and asked if we could do \$5500.00 this year plus room; Eric Glasglow made motion to approve bid for \$5500.00 plus rooms; Donna McDonald seconded; Motion carried; Unanimous

Dare to Be a Cowboy—Bid for \$750.00; Stefanie Moxley made motion to approve the bid for \$750.00; Michael Giorgi seconded; Motion Carried; Unanimous

Fair Poster was presented to the board. Board liked it and will move forward with printing them and getting them out.

Hispanic Day—Board discussed having a Hispanic day on Sunday, maybe bring in dancers and a band on the stage. The board discussed the motorcycle on Sunday and focus on the stage area for Hispanic day.
