Comm. Keller moved to approve the agenda as presented.

Comm. Henderson seconded and the motion passed 5-0.

6. Time Certain

6.a. Time Certain at 09:00 A.M. Public Hearing- Bill No. 22-04: For Possible Action: Approve an Ordinance amending Lyon County Code Title 5, Chapter 5.01.02, by prohibiting the licensing of a cannabis consumption lounge as a business; Title 7, Chapter 2, by prohibiting the consumption of cannabis and cannabis products in a public place; and providing for the severability, constitutionality and effective date thereof; and other matters properly relating thereto.

Community Development Director Andrew Haskin stated this was proposed previously by the Board. There was no response to the business impact statement. He asked if there were any questions.

Comm. Keller moved to approve an Ordinance amending Lyon County Code Title 5, Chapter 5.01.02, by prohibiting the licensing of a cannabis consumption lounge as a business; Title 7, Chapter 2, by prohibiting the consumption of cannabis and cannabis products in a public place; and providing for the severability, constitutionality and effective date thereof; and other matters properly relating thereto.
