1. Call to order by Scott Keller at 7:01pm.
2. Roll Call/Determination of a Quorum: Board members present: Scott Keller, Randy Gahr, and Patricia Allander.

9. Lighting discussion for the Mark Twain Regional Park: Information packets were handed out detailing lighting specifications offered by Musco Lighting. Discussion on LED lighting need and possibilities moving forward. Representatives from Silverada Little League expressed support and need for lighting of area ball fields to encourage out of town teams to play locally and allow games after dark. Musco company representatives to make a presentation at April Board meeting.
10. Lyon County staff report: Rob Dunbar and Kevin Halvorson report crews are ready for the spring. Only two full time staff to maintain parks. County contracted with T&T Lawns Plus for landscaping and lawn maintenance of all parks. Rob re-submitted the land request to the BLM for the proposed future regional park in Silver Springs.
11. Accept projects for ranking and prioritization: Rob Dunbar will re-work the Park Tax spreadsheet to properly reflect projects that have not been completed along with proposed new projects for 2019. The Board will review and be able to assist in prioritizing and ranking the future projects.
