ARPA Funding Request Summary 4-14-2022

County Manager Jeff Page gave an overview of the proceedings of the meeting and presentations. He reported the Lyon County allocations totaled \$11,170,643. The total amount requested was \$16,137,309.76, with available funding in the amount of \$6,162,143.00.

Central Lyon County Fire Protection District

Central Lyon County Fire Protection District Assistant Fire Chief Ryan McIntosh gave a presentation of his request for 2 ambulances and the amount requested of \$436,932.00.

Comm. Gray asked if they could be agreeable to 1 ambulance instead of 2.

Ryan McIntosh answered they can but he also stated 2 is what they need.

Comm. Henderson questioned if the Fire Districts come together for an MOU and find funding with other grants.

Ryan McIntosh reported each district has their own style of ambulances and different brands they work with, but he said it is possible that it could be done.

Comm. Hockaday agreed they could work together to get a better quote. The three districts each submitted different prices.

Mason Valley Fire Protection District

Smith Valley Fire Protection District

Smith Valley Fire Protection District Rob Loveberg, Fire Chief, gave a presentation of his request for 1 ambulance and the amount requested of \$310,624.00.

Comm. Gray asked if they are open to working on an agreement with the other districts and come up with something if they were all able to order through the same company. Chief Loveberg stated he was open to looking into that possibility.
