#### **6.a. For possible action: Presentation on NV NACO's Public Health Coordinator position, Seeking board input from the Lyon County Board of Health on how this position may aid with local health priorities. (Taylor Allison, NV NACO, Public Health Coordinator)**

Taylor Allison, NV NACO, Public Health Coordinator, gave an overview of the NACO Public Health Coordinator position. The NACO Board approved this position roadmap during their March meeting after accepting the CDC Workforce grant in fall of 2021. She is working to establish a state-specific FPHS Framework. NACO is collaborating with key public health leaders and members to conduct an analysis on the gap between current public health services offered in each county compared to what is needed for FPHS implementation.

#### **6.b. For possible action: Presentation on Carson Tahoe Hospitals Community Health Needs assessment, seeking board input on needs and priorities. (Amy Hyne-Sutherland, PhD, Director of Mission Integration)**

Amy Hyne-Sutherland, PhD, Director of Mission Integration, gave an over view of health needs assessment, and they are working with agencies of the communities to gather the data. She asked for any feedback to help her gather more information for needs. There was none at this time. She invited the Board to reach out to her.

#### **6.c. For presentation only: Presentation on Mental Health Awareness month and available local behavioral health services. (Shayla Holmes, Director Lyon County Human Services, Michelle Sandoval, Director Rural Clinics, Amy Rhea, Community Chest Inc., Clinical Director, Laura Yanez, Director NAMI - Western Nevada, and Donna McDonald, Chairman Rural Nevada Counseling)**

Shayla Holmes, Director Lyon County Human Services, gave report of how the COVID-19 pandemic has had a profound impact on the behavioral health of people of all ages. Now, more than ever, it is critical to reduce the stigma around behavioral health struggles, because that stigma often prevents individuals from seeking help. She gave a review of services for families.

Michelle Sandoval, Program Coordinator Rural Clinics, gave an overview of the services they provide in rural clinics.

Laura Yanez, Director NAMI - Western Nevada, gave an overview of the programs of Nevada Warmline statewide and Nevada Teen Text Line.

Donna McDonald and Dr. Juanita Chapman, with Chairman Rural Nevada Counseling, gave review of mental health goals, the path to recovery, and how to access services.
