Call to order, determination of quorum and the Pledge of Allegiance by Penny Slattery.

1. Public participation: AJ Sroa, owner of the Stagecoach market announced the meeting with NDOT in Yerington has been cancelled. Would like the public to show up and say what they would like and NDOT is not answering to anyone. Go to the commissioners meeting about how disgusted we all are at how they are not caring about Stagecoach. June 20th is supposed to be the next scheduled meeting.

 - B. Silver Springs/Stagecoach Hospital Board of Trustees: Vanessa Stuart announced June 20, 2019 is the next meeting. The meetings are every 3rd Thursday of the month. We just appointed 2 new board members so we are a full board once again.
 - C. Public Safety: Sheriffs Dept/NHP: Lt. Ortiz announced the stats for the month of May.

Penny asked the difference between gross misdemeanor and misdemeanor? Gross misdemeanor is between a misdemeanor and a felony.

- D. Animal services: Vanessa Stuart announced next vaccination clinic is June 21, 2019 at Silver Springs shelter 11-4pm. Microchipping is \$15 as well as shots. We are breaking ground on new shelter; getting ready to go into bid. Could start as early as August.

Willis Lamm announced 3 large animal issues. The first is the horses are getting into the partially fenced area and can't find their way out. The second is they are starting to do PZP darting, which is a temporary birth control. People in orange vests with cameras, darting them with CO2 cartridges. The third is there is a horse that was adopted from the pine nuts who has gotten out- look for a shaved box with BLM freeze mark on the side of the neck.

- E. Central Lyon county Fire and Rescue: Charles Lawson apologized for not coming last month. The fire that happened behind Churchill ranchos happened from target shooting. We bought a new/used fire rig. Making \$40,000 worth of write offs- people who can't pay their bill or refused to pay their bill. We have 4000 people signed up for ambulance services. Clean up around fire hydrants, keep them clear. A lot of new hands. Keller persuaded the fire chief to take tumble weeds to fire dept and they will burn them. Going to look into haul away trailers.
- F. Randy Gahr announced this last meeting working on a park project. There is nothing planned for the parks in Stagecoach, nobody has brought anything forward about what to do about the park in Stagecoach. There are 12 different projects going on. The public needs to bring forward ideas as to what they would like done with Spud field in Stagecoach.
