

# Central Lyon County Parks and Recreation Advisory Board Minutes June 19, 2019

1. Call to order by Scott Keller at 7:05pm.
2. Roll Call/Determination of a Quorum: Board members present: Scott Keller, Randy Gahr, and Patricia Allander.  
Staff present: Rob Dunbar                              Public present: None
3. Certification of posting: Received from Randy Gahr and Scott Keller.
4. Public comment: None
5. Approval of agenda: Moved by Patricia Allander; second by Randy Gahr. Passed 3/0.
6. Approval of minutes: Minutes for May 2019 stand with one correction.
7. Lyon County staff report: Kevin is on vacation for two weeks leaving one worker during that period. Rob Dunbar reported that the lawn maintenance company contracted by the county has been performing better. Rob is developing park usage statistics to present to the board at a later meeting. BLM has confirmed that they received the application from the county regarding the land in Silver Springs for potential future regional park. BLM asked for legal description which Rob will provide. BOCC authorized Parks Dept to proceed without them on seeking grants from USDA, etc. State of Nevada Dept of Parks sent a letter reminding the county that they provided grant funding for the Silver Stage Park and Rob and his crew will look into rejuvenating the park to comply with grant requirements.
8. Ranking and prioritization projects: Board combined ranking results of individual score sheets for 12 potential park projects. Mark Twain Park lighting ranked highest on combined scores while Patriot Park swing set ranked lowest. See attached results of project rankings. (Patricia and Randy rated both Mark Twain and Dayton Ballfield lighting with higher scores based on need rather than feasibility. Funding for lighting would be designated for Mark Twain first if available.)
9. Chair/Member comments: Patricia reported that Silver City was hosting free movie nights at the park on Saturday nights all summer. Randy asked residents in his area to bring ideas to present at future meetings. No porta-potty at Pioneer Park and there is also heavy vandalism.
