Call to order, determination of quorum and the Pledge of Allegiance by Penny Slattery.

1. Public participation: Charles Lawson inquired if we get the calendar of events. Annette replied there are different groups who are renting the building during the week, including bingo board. Annette is on the bingo board.

Ron Kennedy announced after April 18, 2019 Board of County Commissioners meeting, there was violations of the open meeting law. Kennedy stated they do not follow Roberts rule of order. Followed up with county manager and go forward with attorney general. There is an investigation under order. There was discussion with lawyer of Vidler privately on the side of this meeting there was a change in the demeanor from commissioners. Need to figure out a way to make sure people are present. Awaiting a phone call back from the attorney general.

B. Silver Springs/Stagecoach Hospital Board of Trustees: Vanessa Stuart announced the next meeting is July 18, 2019. New appointed board members. An election of secretary/treasurer has selected Bridgette Perez.

C. Public Safety: Sheriffs/ NHP: Lt. Ortiz announced the stats. Have safety when dealing with fireworks. The brush and fire will ignite quickly. The fine is \$500. Jail time depends on district attorney.

Penny asked if there has been an increase in vandalism since school let out? Ortiz replied, not really.

Grace Tooker-Bird reported about shooting on property.

Bobbi Kennedy inquired about feedback from the new sheriffs Facebook posts are good and includes a lot of information. How many k9 units? Ortiz replied with 2.

D. Animal services: Vanessa Stuart announced the next animal clinic is August 10. \$15 including microchipping and vaccines. The new shelter's bid has been awarded and

expected to break ground in August. They will be closed on July 4, reopen on the 5<sup>th</sup>. No plans to spay and neuter at the clinic, yet.

- E. Central Lyon county fire and rescue: Charles Lawson announced there was a fire near our park in Dayton today. If you start a fire and don't take any precautions to contain, you get to pay for the whole damages. There are 2 new brush trucks now with the dept. Last year, 3 million dollars in annual fees accrued. Medicare only pays 800 dollars per run and each run costs 2 thousand dollars. Sign up for \$75 ambulance subscription. Everything else that isn't covered in cost, is written off. The fireworks are going to be at the cost of whoever will start a fire. The fire hydrants need to be cleaned and the people want the fire dept to do it, the people should do it themselves. Clean out around hydrant and make sure to keep it clear. The boys are on the job and with a full crew.

Grace Tooker-Bird asked if fee is yearly? Yes, included for the whole family.

Lawson replied you can get one for care flight also.

- F. Central Lyon County Parks and Recreation: Randy Gahr announced the last meeting, BLM received application for regional park in Silver Springs. The BOCC allowed parks to proceed without USDA. Our park and pioneer park getting porta potty. Applications available for what to do with the park in Stagecoach.

Penny announced they need to get rid of outbuilding at pioneer park due to apparent vandalism occurring. We still have spud field. Perhaps we need to run on the agenda asking for ideas on how to use spud field over the next few meetings.
