Meeting Minutes

1. Call to order - Meeting was called to order by Bridget Perez at 7:00 P.M.
2. Roll call: Determination of Quorum - Members present: Bridget Perez, Stacy Sell, Mike Irvin, Scott Keller, and Peggy Quigg – with all Members present, a quorum was established.
3. Pledge of Allegiance - Bridget Perez led the Pledge of Allegiance.
4. Public Participation: Tom Hendrix commented that the Lyon County School Board was scheduled to meet on July 26th at the School District Offices in Yerington. The proposed agenda for this meeting included a discussion item on a major revision of the dress code for all Lyon County Schools (K-12). The proposed revision would essentially eliminate the dress code. Citizens interested in this issue are encouraged to attend the meeting.
5. Action Item: Mike Irvin made A motion to approve the meeting agenda for the July 11, 2022, Silver Springs Advisory Board meeting. The motion was seconded by Peggy Quigg. The motion was approved with a vote of 5 to zero.
6. For Possible Action: Stacy Sell noted a correction to item # 5 on the draft minutes of the May 2, 2022, Silver Springs Advisory Board Meeting. The draft indicated four members approving the May 2nd Agenda when the actual count was 5 members voting to approve. The correction was noted, and the minutes were approved pending the correction.
7. Community reports:
 - Silver Stage High School Bridget Perez, Silver Stage High School Faculty Member stated that the School District was in process of accepting applications for the addition of a modular unit to be added to the High School. She also stated that there is currently an opening in

the Lyon County School Board and encouraged anyone interested to apply.

- Lyon County Library Board – Peggy Quigg Lyon County Library Board of Trustee member reported that the Silver Springs Library was hosting a Star Gazing event on Thursday night, July 14 at 9:00 P.M. A guest astronomer will be conducting “tours of the skies” and present educational information. All are welcome.
- Silver Springs Area Chamber of Commerce Acting Chair, Vida Keller and Tom Hendrix shared information on the new Chamber of Commerce website. The new website will be hosted on a new hosting site called WildApricot.com. The new address is:

Mr. Hedrick encouraged people to get signed up on the contact list and get involved in Chamber activities.
- Lyon County Planning Commissioner, Tammy Hendrix stated there was nothing to report from the Planning Commission meeting.
- Central Lyon County Fire Department – Ray Johnson reported that the Department recently filled a Captain position a Fire Inspector position. He further stated that the Fire Department is working on a proposal to staff the Silver Springs and Dayton fire stations full time. They are in the process of exploring a ballot initiative that would impose a district wide tax increase in order to fund the increase in staffing. The process is not totally clear and were several comments regarding timelines and what the actual process for getting an item on an upcoming ballot might be.
- Lyon County Board of Commissioner Vida Keller stated that the County Commission has been taking care of a lot of housekeeping issues. One significant item is how developers submit zoning maps. Developers will now be required to complete a zoning map checklist and once all items are completed, it will go to the Development Director for final approval and sign off. Then the in-house map will be created based on all items listed on the checklist. This will streamline the process and ensure that all items have been addressed before the final map is created for approval.

Commissioner Keller addressed a question regarding the status of the waste management contract. She stated that the RFP process was challenged, and the County is still reviewing the best method to resolve the protest and issue a final contract award.

8. Correspondence:

- Bridget Perez stated that there had been an increase in vandalism at County Parks, libraries, and other county properties. As a committee, she encouraged us to be attentive to this and be on the look-out for unusual activity at such properties and alert local law enforcement.

9. Chair and Board Member comments:

- Bridget Perez suggested that we invite someone from the Central Lyon Fire Department to present more detailed information at the August Silver Springs Advisory Board Meeting. She said that she would follow up on this and reach out to the Fire District.

10. Public Participation:

- Scott Keller stated that the Advisory Board was getting caught up on the County's requirement to have all meeting agendas, minutes and recordings posted on the Google Drive.

He encouraged everyone to invite people to come to the meetings and start filling seats again and share information with the Board members on upcoming events. He reminded everyone that these are public meetings and citizen input is important.

Vida Keller reminded everyone that the Lyon County Library Foundation Annual Masquerade Ball fund raiser is on October 22nd. People are encouraged to purchase tickets or sponsor tables.
