Paul Fuselier, Sierra Front Field Office Manager gave updates on the Anaconda Mine site disposal, Vero fiber optic line, El Dorado Dam, Pine Nut Mountains abandoned mine hazard closures, Minister road project, Wabuska geothermal project, OHV race special recreation permits, proposed solar projects, realty updates and fuels update.
