9. **BOCC Items: A** *For Possible Action: To Forward a recommendation to the Board of Commissioners on a draft resolution requesting to reduce the speed limit from 60 to 45 miles per hour on Highway 50 in Dayton from Fortune Drive to La Fond Avenue and to report what business, economic, or traveling impacts would be experienced by the community.*

Mike Irvin opened the meeting to public comment:

Both the Board and the community members in attendance had concerns regarding access on to and from the highway, stating the source of most incidents in the area listed above are vehicles pulling out in front of them without ample space or opportunity to accelerate up to highway speeds. Similarly, people also spoke on vehicles in front of them slamming on their brakes without enough notice in an attempt to exit the highway. No one present had specific incidences of how the potential reduction in speed would have business, economic or traveling impacts outside of minimal increases to travel/commute time.

Mike Irvin closed the meeting to public comment.

Nancy Broughton moved to forward a letter of transmittal to the BOCC listing the concerns and experiences mentioned above. Andrea Bellman seconded the motion. The motion passed (4-0)

Chair Mike Irvin stated: Reducing speed on 95 past Spruce as trucks are still entering and exiting the highway. Chair Mike Irvin opened the meeting to public comment

Doug Bennett stated there are issues with the horses near the NDOT station and Silver Strike Casino on HWY 50, asking if the cattle guard can be moved to the east side of the roundabout. Community members stated adding acceleration/deceleration, longer turn lanes would be beneficial throughout 95.
