



HOME ARTS EXHIBIT REGULATIONS

NO Pre-Entry Required for open Division

- Age Classifications
 *Youth—Any youth under 18 years
 *FFA/4-H—Any youth currently enrolled in the FFA or 4-H program, clover buds or youth age 5-8
- Each exhibitor may enter only five items per class, (i.e. Exhibitor may enter five leather craft belts. There is a limit in the “other” category but entry cannot duplicate any other entry in its class.
- 4-H entries must be accompanied by Project Record Sheet.
- Exhibits will be removed **MONDAY, AUGUST 18, 2025, 10:00 AM TO 3:00 PM. Early removal MUST BE PRE ARRANGED.**
- Exhibits must meet regulations outlined in this catalog. Management may refuse items that do not meet qualifications.
- NO EXHIBIT WILL BE RELEASED WITHOUT A VALID CLAIM CHECK.**
- The management will use every precaution for the safe preservation of all articles and exhibits but **WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE**, whatever may be the cause or extent of damage or loss.
- All entries will be judged on the Danish and American System. All entries receive either a blue, red or white award. 1st, 2nd & 3rd place awarded in each class. Best of Show in each section awarded. Best of Show/Best of Class awarded with a minimum of 3 entries or at judge’s discretion. Late entries will not be eligible for awards.
- Professionals may exhibit “For Display Only”.
- Perishable Food Exhibits **will not be returned after the Fair**, however, the ornaments, decorations, ribbons and judging sheet will be available for exhibitors.
- The Fair Board reserves the right to settle any and all arguments which may arise in the interpretation of the rules.
- Articles exhibited must be the work of the person in whose name they are entered, must have been made in the last three years. Quilts must have been made within the last five years and not previously exhibited in the Lyon County Fair.
- The owner or custodian of property of any kind brought to the fairgrounds, either for exhibit or for other purposes, assumes, as a condition of its admission to the grounds, all risk of, and responsibility for, its loss, damage or theft. The Fair and its officers and employees cannot, and will not, accept responsibility and liability for any damage or injury resulting from theft, fire, the elements, accidents or other conditions and causes, whether to the exhibits, property of concessionaires, vehicles, on the grounds and articles left therein or any property of any nature whatsoever. Exhibitors exempt the Lyon County Fair, its officer, directors, and employees from liability for loss, damage or injury to himself or his property by any animal owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify the said Lyon County Fair against all claims, and any injuries or damages arising from actions or negligence of the exhibitors.
- Best of Class, Best of Show, and People’s Choice awards will only be awarded ribbons.
NO MONEY AWARDS WILL BE PAID.
- Exhibit Hall will be closed to public during judging.


