PUBLIC NOTICE

Visitor Restrictions

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) has advised people to take precautions in light of the coronavirus outbreak and that the best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to the virus.

To minimize exposure to COVID-19 and avoid disruption to critical court functions, the Third Judicial District Court has imposed visitor restrictions.

YOU MUST WEAR A MASK WHEN IN ANY PUBLIC AREA OF THIS BUILDING, INCLUDING ANY COURTROOM

Effective immediately, the following persons **shall not enter** the courthouse:

1. Persons who have been diagnosed with COVID-19;
2. Persons who have been asked to self-quarantine by any doctor, hospital, or health agency;
3. Persons with apparent symptoms of COVID-19, such as fever, severe cough, or shortness of breath.

Anyone attempting to enter in violation of these protocols will be denied entry by Courthouse Security.
